

SUMMARY

Occuring of *Sarcoscypha austriaca* in the Southern Roztocze Landscape Park

Sarcoscypha austriaca (O. Beck ex Sacc.) Boud. is a fungus placed in the *Sarcoscyphaceae* family, the *Pezizales* order, the *Ascomycetes* class, the *Ascomycota* phylum, and the *Fungi* kingdom. It occurs on wood of several tree and shrub taxa (*Alnus*, *Salix*, *Acer*, *Betula*, *Corylus* and *Robinia pseudoacacia*). It is known from the Alps and Carpathian Mts., where it grows in riverine alder forests and willow bushes, and in fertile beech-maple woods. The species is very rare in Poland. So far, it has been found only in the Mazurian Lakeland. At locality near Siedliska, the Southern Roztocze Landscape Park, *S. austriaca* was observed (in 2004 and 2006) under loose canopy of robinia-oak-pine stand.
