SUMMARY

New station of Fistulina hepatica (Schaeff.): Fr. in the vicinity of Koszalin

Fistulina hepatica is a fungus included in the Red list of macromycetes with category "vulnerable" (V) (Wojewoda, Ławrynowicz 1992). New locality of the species has been recorded on old oaks growing on a hill called Czaple Wzgórze, near buildings of Manowo forestry (Koszalin district, Zachodniopomorskie Province) (Fig. 1). The hill is overgrown by old tree stands with spruces, hemlock-spruces, limes and beeches. Because of special natural values of the area a natural route was created.
