SUMMARY

Bat fauna of the Kotlina Żywiecka basin

The Kotlina Żywiecka basin is situated in the western part of the Carpathians (southern Poland). Occurrence of bat species was investigated there in 1992-2003. Netting, ultrasound detectors and inspections of summer shelters were used. Altogether 11 species were recorded: Rhinolophus hipposideros, Myotis nattereri, M. mystacinus, M. brandtii, M. daubentonii, Vespertilio murinus, Eptesicus nilssonii, Nyctalus noctula, N. leisleri, Plecotus auritus, P. austriacus. The most numerously mist-netted were M. daubentonii and M. brandtii (Tab. 1). The main threats of bats in the Kotlina Żywiecka basin are lack of forests and urbanisation of river valleys.
