SUMMARY

Cuber P. A new locality of *Iris sibirica* L. at the Kozłowa Góra Reservoir (Upper Silesia, S Poland).

The occurrence of this protected and quite rare in Poland species was recorded on the eastern bank of the reservoir near Ossy village (50°25'50" N, 18°59'20" E) in 2005–2006. A population of about 1000 flowering and bearing fruits clumps was found on moist meadow 300–500 m from the reservoir bank.
