SUMMARY

Suski A., Suska K. Localities of Galanthus nivalis L. and Leucoium vernum L. in the Piekielna Dolina Valley in Polanica Zdrój (Kotlina Kłodzka, SW Poland).

Galanthus nivalis was observed on three localities (S1, S2, S5; Fig. 1) in riparian zone of the Bystrzyca Dusznicka in early spring 2007. The

patches of an area from a few to about 60 ares were recorded where the species covered 15–100% of the surface. *Leucoium vernum* occurred at the same places and at two other moist and fertile localities (S3, S4; Fig. 1). The area of patches of L. vernum ranged between 1.5 and 10 ares and this species covered 3–95% of the surface.
