

SUMMARY

Sołtys-Lelek A. *Allium ursinum* L. is back to the Ojców National Park.

Allium ursinum were recorded at only 11 sites in the Wyżyna Krakowsko-Częstochowska Upland (S Poland). The occurrence of *A. ursinum* within the Ojców National Park territory was reported by Rostafiński in the second half of the 19th century and despite many floristic studies this species has not been confirmed in this area until 2006. In June 2006, a small population consisted of 22 specimens was found near Ojców village (DF48 square of the ATPOL grid) in Carpathian beech wood *Dentario glandulosae-Fagetum*. The accompanying species were *Aegopodium podagraria*, *Geranium phaeum*, *Asarum europaeum*, *Anemone nemorosa*, *Acer platanoides*, *Primula elatior*, *Urtica dioica*, *Geranium robertianum*, *Lamium maculatum*, *Impatiens parviflora*, and *Isopyrum thalictroides*.
