Renaturalization of water conditions is appropriate way of preventing the area of the Kampinos Primeval Forest from progressive drying. At present, the restoration of the state from a few decades ago is impossible. However, one can restore the former conditions of uptake and drainage of ground waters, and of the outflow of surface waters. Consequently, it provides an opportunity of suppressing the progressive degradation of ecosystems, and it can stimulate the restitution of valuable natural marsh settlements, which are typical for this area. Accordingly, the proposal of such activity was contained in the Plan of the KPN Protection, and a part of it was already carried out.
