SUMMARY

Activity of brown bear Ursus arctos L. in the Babia Góra massif

The brown bear Ursus arctos L. is not a species which permanently sits in Babia Góra massif It appears here only transitively. In last years this predator has been observed often in the area of Babia Góra National Park and in its environs. First data concerning presence of brown bear in the park come from 1868. Since that time to June 2004, altogether 69 pieces of information about bears were gathered. Only two times bear's hibernation was ascertained on Babia Góra massif: in 1957 and 2004.
