

SUMMARY

A new station of *Liparis loeselii* (L.) Rich. in the Wielkopolska province

Liparis loeselii (L.) Rich. is an endangered species in Poland. Since 1980 only 52 localities have been confirmed.

In the 2005 the authors have discovered a new locality of *Liparis loeselii* situated in the NE part of the Promno Landscape Park, near Kazanie Lake. The population consisted of almost 60 individuals growing on calcareous fen. *Liparis loeselii* is the component of plant community belonging to alliance *Caricion davallianae*. The accompanying species were: *Drosera anglica*, *Epipactis palustris*, *Utricularia minor*, *Utricularia intermedia*.
