

SUMMARY

The hitherto known localities of twin-flower on the Mierzeja Wiślana Spit are situated in the surrounding of Mikoszewo village (2 sites) and near Piaski village (1 site). New locality was found in the middle part of the Spit near Piaski in 2006. Discovered locality has been characterized by an exceptional viability of the population, which acreage of occurrence increased from 200 m² in 2006 to 300 m² in 2007. Twin-flower occurs in the undergrowth of fresh coniferous forest. The tree stand, mainly of Scots pine, on this locality reaches the age of 100 years. Flowering individuals have not been found. Presumably, it is the locality of a semi-natural character occupying the top of the dune rampart at the height of 30 meters above sea level.
