

SUMMARY

Faunal peculiarities of small post-glacial water body near Skanda Lake in Olsztyn (Warmia and Mazury voivodeship)

This paper contains a general description on the small water body situated in the south eastern part of the Olsztyn city and its interesting fauna. This water reservoir is characterized by the high species richness and the occurrence of some rare and endangered species. The presence of numerous population of Swan Mussel *Anodonta cygnea* was observed. This population was characterized by large size of the mussel, bigger than observed last years in other reservoirs of Poland.
