

SUMMARY

Rosa gallica L. in the Iłża Foreland (Małopolska Upland)

Rosa gallica is rare and vulnerable species, protected in Poland. It has been reported from many localities in Poland but recently become increasingly rare. In the years 2005-2006, *R. gallica* was found in Wesołówka and Sulejów villages (ATPOL grid square: FE 62 02). It grows on the border of arable fields on calcareous soil and in the cherry orchard.
