SUMMARY

Spałek K. A new locality of $Utricularia\ ochroleuca\ R.\ W.\ Hartm.$ on the Opole Silesia (SW Poland).

Utricularia ochroleuca is considered endangered species in Poland and extinct in the Opole Silesia. In 2007 the new locality of *U. ochroleuca* was found near Kolonowskie (square CF08 of the ATPOL grid; 50°38'84" N, 18°24'38" E). Several dozen specimens grows in the abandoned canal (width 2–8 m, maximum depth about 1.5 m, sandy and muddy bottom, very slow flow of unpolluted, mesotrophic water). This is only 1 known site of *U. ochroleuca* within the Opole Silesia territory.
