

SUMMARY

Piątek K. Protected and threatened vascular plants of the neighbourhood of Jodłowa in the Pogórze Ciężkowickie Hills (SE Poland).

Floristic investigations of an area of 100 km² within the EF: 89 square of the ATPOL grid were carried out in 2003–2007. Flora of vascular plants consisted of 588 taxa; in that number there are 36 protected and 13 threatened species. The largest number of these species (25) was recorded in the Czubaczna-Zamczysko Hill near Dęborzyn (2×2-km subsquare EF: 89–03), while in most of remaining squares their number did not exceed 10.
