SUMMARY

A. Czarna. Galium pumilum Murray in the Wielkopolska (W Poland).

Chrońmy Przyrodę Ojczystą 64 (3): 26-30.

The first locality of *Galium pumilum*, a rare species included into the Polish Red Data Book, was found in the Wielkopolska region in 2006. The locality (52°58'40" N, 16°49'10" E) lies about 4 km to the west from Chodzież. *G. pumilum* occurred on the edge of a pine forest and on the roadside of the road to Czarnków (mainly on the left hand side along a 2-km section) and the local road to Ujście (on both sides along a 2-km section too) at their crossing. The population at this locality amounting to around 20 thousands specimens and, on the basis of published data, belongs probably to the largest ones in Poland. The possible threat to this population may be road and forest works and, therefore, it should be monitored.
