

SUMMARY

Linosyris vulgaris has been included in the list of species threatened in Lublin region (VU). Within the last six years (2001–2007) field surveys at sites where the plant had previously been reported (Parchatka, Kazimierz Dolny, Stara Wieś, Opoczka, Wirkowice, Broczówka, Gródek and Dzierążnia Kościelna) did not confirm its occurrence. The only confirmed site is situated near the village Tarnogóra near Izbica (50°53'40" N, 23°07'00" E). *L. vulgaris* grows there abundantly in patches of xerothermic vegetation on the loess slopes of the Wieprz River valley, intersected with deep ravines. Generous blooming and presence of young plants imply good condition and remarkable viability of this population. In the authors' opinion, this site of *L. vulgaris* will not be endangered in the next years.
