

SUMMARY

Ławicki Ł. Breeding of the Oystercatcher *Haematopus ostralegus*, Ringed Plover *Charadrius hiaticula* and Little Tern *Sternula albifrons* in the lower Odra River valley (NW Poland).

Oystercatchers were breeding (3–4 pairs) in gravel-pits in Bielinek, Chlewice and Kaleńsko, and on the meadows in Gozdowice in 2004–2006. Ringed Plover was only ephemeral breeder. During 2004–2005 4–6 breeding pairs occurred, but in 2006 no nesting birds were recorded. Little Tern were recorded in 5 localities with a total of 10–30 pairs. The most important site for that species is gravel-pit in Chlewice, where most of the whole population occurring in the lower Odra River valley breed.
