

## SUMMARY

### **A new site of *Dianthus superbis* L. in the Opole Silesia (SW Poland)**

On 31 July 2004, a new site of this protected and rare in the Opole Province plant species was recorded on an abandoned meadow located in the Ścinawa Niemodlińska River valley at the Rączka village (50°28'40" N, 17°35'30" E). There were 100–200 specimens clumped in four groups, covering, in total, an area of 125 m<sup>2</sup>.
