SUMMARY

A new site of Dianthus superbus L. in the Opole Silesia (SW Poland)

On 31 July 2004, a new site of this protected and rare in the Opole Province plant species was recorded on an abandoned meadow located in the Ścinawa Niemodlińska River valley at the Rączka village $(50^{\circ}28'40"\ N,\ 17^{\circ}35'30"\ E)$. There were 100-200 specimens clumped in four groups, covering, in total, an area of $125\ m^2$.
