

SUMMARY

A new station of butter bolete *Boletus regius* Krombh. in Słonne Mountains

The butter bolete is a rare and endangered species in whole Europe. On the *Red list of the macrofungi in Poland* it belongs to the category “E” – endangered to die out. This category is currently in force.

The unique site where the butter bolete could be found in Poland until 2005 was Roztoka Valley in the Beskid Sądecki Mountains.

Two new sites have been discovered one year ago in Podkarpackie Province. The first – by me in the Słonne Mountains (a part of the Sanocko-Turczańskie Mountains), in the square ATPOL FG-16 at August 20th, 2005; the second – by Marek Zajdek near Jasło city.
